

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF VISION SERVICE PLAN FOR VISION INSURANCE FOR VILLAGE EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Vision Service Plan for the provision of insurance for full-time employees effective January 1, 2001, a copy of which bid is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide needed insurance coverage for Village employees; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Dear Eleanor:

Enclosed is a hard copy of Vision Service Plan for The Village of Richfield. We will need to do three things to have an effective date of January 1, 2001. These three must be sent to Vision Service Plan by the first week of December.

The biggest item is a list of the 49 employees by social security number, name, and marital status. We have all this except for social security numbers. If CIGNA has social security numbers on their billing, I could secure a copy and add these numbers to the enclosed list. Secondly, the enclosed Group Vision Care Plan Application must be completed. I have done a copy as to how this may be completed. If you agree, have it typed and signed by Mayor. Lastly, we will need a binder check for \$962.22 for the January premium.

As you can see, January rates have adjusted 4.5 per cent to \$9.92 per single employee and \$22.45 for family for Ohio Political Groups of 10 to 100 employees. Rates are guaranteed for the first two years. Proposed Plan is Plan A with a \$10.00 Co-pay.

After Vision Service Plan receives the above three items, employees will receive kits and claim information for their plan. Basically, if claimants use a VSP Doctor, most items are covered in full with only a \$10.00 co-pay for exam. Enclosed is a list of VSP Doctors for the Akron-Cleveland area.
