

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A FIRST RENEWAL INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, DIVISION OF ANIMAL CONTROL FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village passed Resolution No. 64-2015 that authorized and directed the Mayor and Finance Director to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for Animal Control Services ("Agreement") with Summit County Department of Administrative Services, Division of Animal Control ("County"); and

WHEREAS, the 5-year Agreement between the Village and the County is set to expire on August 31, 2020 but allows the Village and County to renew the Agreement for one (1) additional five (5) year period; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended to Council renew the Agreement with the County for one (1) additional five (5) year period.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized and directed to enter a five (5) year First Renewal of Intergovernmental Agreement for Animal Control Services with Summit County, Department of Administrative Services, Division of Animal Control for a term to begin September 1, 2020, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to ensure that there is no disruption in the animal control services provided by the County to the Village; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



**FIRST RENEWAL OF
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
for ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES
between
THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT
AND
THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD**

This First Renewal of Intergovernmental Agreement for Animal Control Services (the "Agreement") is effective as of September 1, 2020 between the Village of Richfield (the "Village"), duly authorized by Ordinance No. 64-2015, and the County of Summit, Ohio through the Department of Administrative Services, Division of Animal Control, duly authorized by Resolution No. 2015-361 (the "County").

The County and the Village hereby agree to renew the Agreement, originally effective September 1, 2015, for one (1) additional term for a five (5) year period, commencing on September 1, 2020 and terminating on August 31, 2025.

The original Agreement and this Renewal, is authorized by County Council Resolution No. 2015-361 and Village Resolution No. 64-2105

The County and the Village hereby agree as follows:

1. The Agreement, which was effective September 1, 2015 and authorized by County Council Resolution No. 2015-361, shall be renewed for a one (1) additional term for a five (5) year period, beginning September 1, 2020 and shall terminate on August 31, 2025.
2. Either party may terminate the Agreement on an earlier date with at least sixty (60) days prior written notice of termination to the other party.
3. The Village agrees to pay fees to the County for all services rendered by the County under this Renewal according to the fee schedule stated in the original Agreement.
4. All other terms and conditions in the original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
