

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR A SCHOOL ZONE FLASHER LIGHT SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for a school zone flasher light system in accordance with the plans and specifications previously prepared and on file in his office.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder as determined by Council.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for safety of school children; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
